



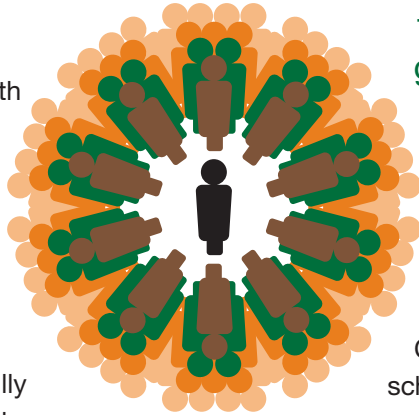
# The Cycle of Abuse is talked about often... but do we really understand it?

One 12 year old boy who is traveling down the wrong path in life can negatively affect **hundreds of lives** during his lifetime. That's hundreds!

We can actually prevent hundreds of other cycles from starting if we successfully redirect that 12 year old boy by:

- giving him the realization that what happened to him does not have to happen to others.
- helping him understand what happened to him, and how to deal with those feelings
- giving him the tools to be a safe and productive member of our society.
- giving him the education and independent living skills he needs to succeed.
- working with the families, as appropriate.

By redirecting him toward a successful future, hundreds of others can be spared from becoming part of the cycle of this one boy.



Generations is a nationally-accredited residential program working with up to 58 boys at any given time. Sexual abuse is stopped and prevented at Generations through a structured, staff secure, rehabilitative program in a home-like setting. Sexual behavior management and various skill-building groups are tailored to the specific needs of each boy. Through these specialized services, education, recreation and leisure skills, family reunification and spiritual development we realize our goal of "no more victims."



## **gives them an education,**

Realizing that success also hinges on education, GGH has an on-site, year-round school supported by Greenville County. GGH graduates boys with high school diplomas and encourages college courses through Greenville Technical College.

## **gives them a childhood experience,**

Learning to be a child is a big component of our program. Many of our boys have not had an appropriate childhood and learning to play is extremely important. Through structured recreational therapy, our Boy Scout Troop #821, and special events and holidays at Generations, our boys learn the joys of childhood.

## **gives them a future,**

Family Reunification is also a large part of our program. When appropriate, each family is encouraged to become involved in their child's treatment plan. As this is not always possible, Generations' Staff seeks out a stabilizing adult to be a part of the process to help with his successful transition into today's society.

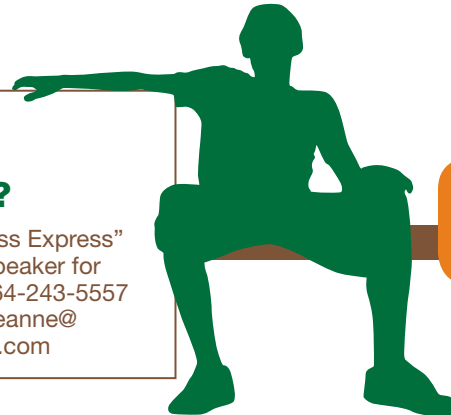
## **offers them spiritual direction,**
