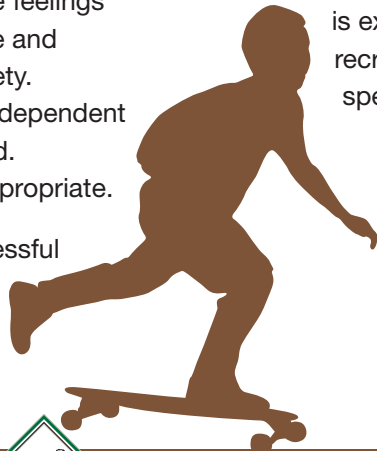
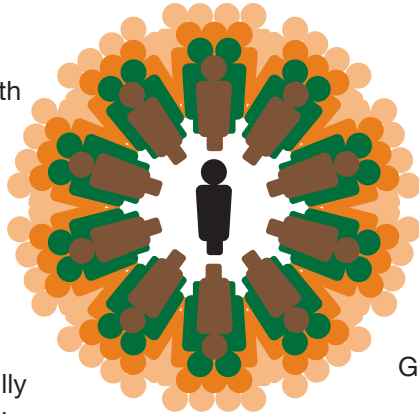
The Cycle of Abuse is talked about often... but do we really understand it?

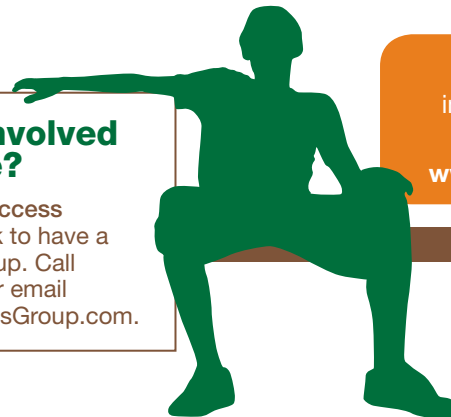
offers them spiritual direction.
